

For best results:

Print on a good heavy paper, referred to as cardstock. I like a satin or gloss coated finish. Non-laminated. Preferable paper weight may be labeled as:

- 270g/m²
- 80-100 lb.
- 8pt-topt.
- cardstock
- coverstock

Cut out the dodecahedron with an exacto or matte knife.

Very lightly score the tabs and folded edges. Lightly bend all tabs and folds before gluing. Some glossy finished paper may require scuffing or scraping of the surface for proper glue adhesion.


Glue one tab at a time starting with the September side of the calendar. The December panel has no tabs and is intended to be the final panel to be glued into place.

I've found wood glue to be an ideal adhesive. Strong, yet quick to cure and without warping paper. You will want to use a sparse amount of glue, especially if you use more delicate paper.
